# Directions

Garberville is located in southern Humboldt County, about 200 miles north of San Francisco, along scenic Highway 101. From downtown Garberville head west on Sprowel Creek Road 1.0 mile. The Community Park entrance is well marked.

Southern Humboldt Community Park encompasses hundreds of acres along the Wild & Scenic South Fork of the Eel River, and includes such diverse bird habitats as grassland, farmland, riverine and riparian, mixed hardwood and conifer forests, old growth bay laurel, emergent wetlands, and towering redwoods.
